<u>Ordinary Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered with thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	3.65	.90	.60
<u>14-Day Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	4.25	.90	.60
<u>Expedited Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	4.85	.90	.60
<u>Daily Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day.	6.05	1.20	.90
