Daniel Lenz, counsel for plaintiff Daniel C. Hoffman, has moved for authorization of attorney fees and costs for his representation of plaintiff. Counsel is seeking \$2,248.15 in fees and \$400 in costs under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412. Defendant Carolyn W. Colvin, Acting Commissioner of the Social Security Administration, does not oppose plaintiff's counsel's request. Accordingly, I am granting plaintiff's counsel's motion.

After counsel for the parties verify that plaintiff owes no pre-existing debt subject to offset, defendant shall pay \$2,248.15 in fees and \$400 in costs to counsel in accordance with the assignment signed by plaintiff and his counsel.

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Daniel C. Hoffman's motion for attorney fees in the

amount of \$2,248.15 and costs in the amount of \$400, dkt. #13, is GRANTED.
