Presently pending before the Court in the above entitled matter is defendant Thomas W. Dabruzzi's demand to transfer post-judgment garnishment proceedings to the District of Minnesota and for a hearing. Both requests will be denied.

Defendant has failed to suggest any basis for his demand other than the fact that he resides in said District.

It is the obligation and responsibility of this Court to resolve the Writ of Continuing Garnishment as well as the collection and enforcement of those criminal penalties which may be imposed. Defendant's lack of substantive basis that would warrant a hearing under the Federal Debt Collection Procedure Act further suggests that this Court has all information available to it in order to resolve the concerns relating to the enforcement of a criminal judgment that imposes a fine or restitution in accordance with the practices and procedures for the enforcement of a criminal judgment under federal or state law.
