Defendant Jerry Hallgren has filed a motion for early termination of his supervised release. His motion is DENIED. From the record, it appears that defendant has made significant efforts to comply with all of his conditions of release and that he has made significant positive changes in his life, including completion of a drug treatment program and maintaining full time employment. However, because defendant was involved in a very serious offense involving large amounts of methamphetamine and alleged gun activity, it is too early to consider termination of his supervised release.

If defendant continues to remain compliant with his conditions of release, I would

be willing to consider a petition from the United States probation office for early termination in March of 2012.
