The United States has written to request a suspension of the briefing schedule. The request is GRANTED.

As the government points out, Mr. Miller's second in forma pauperis motion is accompanied by a brief that addresses only ten of the thirty-two issues that defendant sets out in his amended petition.

It makes sense to allow defendant an opportunity to supplement his brief and then to give the government two weeks to reply.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Stacey Miller may have until September 21, 2004, in which to supplement his brief to address the remaining twenty-two issues left unaddressed in his initial brief. The government may have until October 14, 2004, in which to respond

to defendant's petition.
