Defendant Henry L. Jackson has filed a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a modification of the sentence imposed upon him on August 8, 2002. Defendant filed a previous § 3582 motion on April 1, 2008, dkt. #49. The federal defender, acting on defendant's behalf, and the United States Attorney briefed the motion and on January 5, 2009, I entered an order granting defendant's motion, reducing defendant's sentence of imprisonment from 188 months to 150 months. Because defendant Jackson has already received the benefit of a sentence reduction under 18 U.S.C. § 3582, he is not entitled to another one.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Henry L. Jackson's motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is DENIED as moot.
