Plaintiff has moved for a 30-day enlargement of time to April 10, 2003, in which to
pay the initial partial payment of the fee for filing an appeal assessed in each of these cases

on February 19, 2003. Plaintiff explains that his release account funds have been moved to an interest bearing account outside the prison. He states also that he recently entered into a settlement agreement in another lawsuit and a check has been deposited into his prison account which is subject to a four week hold pending clearance of the check through a Nashville, Tennessee bank. Plaintiff states that when the hold on his settlement funds has been lifted, he will submit full payment of the \$105 fee for filing each of his appeals. His request will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Algenone Williams may have an enlargement of time to April 10, 2003, in which to pay \$2.79 in each of these cases as an initial partial payment of the \$105 fee for filing his appeal or to pay the full \$105 fee in each case. If, by April 10, 2003, plaintiff does not pay at least the initial partial payments assessed, then I will advise

the court of appeals of that fact so that it may take whatever steps it deems appropriate with respect to his appeals.
