A telephone status conference was held in this case on August 6, 2003, before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Paul Bauer participated on behalf of plaintiff. Michael Latsch and Rainer Zahnhausen participated on behalf of defendant Christine Strunk. Also participating in the conference call at the court's request was Jeff McIntyre, former counsel for defendant.

Counsel for defendant advised the court that defendant does not have the financial resources to defend herself at the trial scheduled for August 25, 2003. Counsel were informed that unless the case settled before August 25, 2003, it would go forward as a trial on damages only unless defendant appeared to defend herself.

If the trial is not defended, plaintiff may prefer a court trial over a jury trial. Mr. Bauer is to advise the clerk of court no later than Friday, August 8, 2003, whether a default trial on damages only will be tried to the court or to a jury.
