On December 2, 2003, this court held a telephonic scheduling conference. Plaintiff Nathaniel Lindell appeared on his own behalf. The remaining three defendants, Steven Houser, William Schultz and Jeffrey Friday, appeared by Assistant Attorney General David Hoel.

First I set briefing on plaintiff's motion to reconsider a small portion of the November 21, summary judgment order. See "motion to allow Lindell to pursue damages for transfer," dkt. 113. Defendants may file and serve a response by December 12, 2003. Plaintiff may file and serve a reply by December 19, 2003.

Discovery may continue until January 30, 2004. Discovery is *over* on that date, so the parties must time any additional discovery requests accordingly.

The parties must file and serve their trial witness lists not later than February 2, 2004.

The final pretrial conference shall be March 1, 2004, at 8:30 a.m. The parties may

submit proposals for this conference according to the directions in the court's standing order

governing the final pretrial conference, a copy of which was attached to the preliminary

pretrial conference order.

Jury selection and trial shall begin March 1, 2004, at 9:00 a.m. The parties are

predicting no more than 1-2 days for trial.

Plaintiff may be seeking a copy of the court's plan for drawing the venire pool for his

jury. If he wishes to pursue this, he should send a letter request to the clerk of court.

Finally, in response to plaintiff's request (dkt. 112), I have attached to this order

pages 33 and 34 of the court's November 21, 2003, summary judgment order which

apparently was mailed without these pages.

The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
