On November 29, 2002, plaintiff was granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis in this action on his claim that defendants Dr. Safari, Cindy Sawinski, Jolene Miller, Nurse Jo and Gerald Berge were deliberately indifferent to his serious medical needs. The order granting leave to proceed appears to have crossed in the mail with a letter from plaintiff dated December 2, 2002, in which he states that he has learned that the full name of the defendant he identifies as "Nurse Jo" is Jolinda Waterman. I construe plaintiff's letter as a motion to amend his complaint to substitute the name Jolinda Waterman in the caption of the complaint and wherever plaintiff refers to defendant "Nurse Jo" in the body of his complaint. The motion will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion to amend his complaint is GRANTED to substitute the name Jolinda Waterman in the caption and the body of plaintiff's complaint for the name "Nurse Jo."
