On October 22, 2003, defendant filed a “request to supplement defendant’s proposed findings of fact.” In the request, defendant sought to include two additional factual statements in support of its motion for summary judgment. However, on October 24, 2003, defendant filed its reply to plaintiff’s response to the motion for summary judgment. In the reply, defendant has proposed the two factual statements it sought to include in its request to supplement in response to plaintiff’s proposed facts numbered 4 and 26. Because the proposed factual statements made in the request to supplement were properly submitted in reply to plaintiff’s proposed facts 4 and 26, it is not necessary to consider whether defendant should be allowed to proposed the factual statements as “supplements.” Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that defendant’s October 22, 2003 request to supplement its proposed findings

of fact is DENIED as moot.
