Petitioner Timmy Terrell Lott filed this action in December 2002 while he was a prisoner at the Oshkosh Correctional Institution in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Before the complaint could be screened on its merits as required under the 1996 Prison Litigation Reform Act, the court learned that petitioner had been released from prison on January 7, 2003. It now has been seven weeks and petitioner has not advised the court of his current address. His lack of communication with the court suggests that he is no longer interested in prosecuting this action.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice for

petitioner's failure to prosecute.
