On November 2, 2005, defendant filed a motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. In his cover letter accompanying the motion, he says he will be filing a memorandum and brief in support of his motion on or before November 27, 2005. As of the date of this order, defendant has failed to file any such memorandum or brief. If defendant does not file any documents in support of his § 2255 motion by December 12, 2005, the court will proceed to consider the motion as filed. In this instance, defendant will not have the opportunity to file a second motion to modify or vacate his sentence except in unusual circumstances and then only after he has received permission from the Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit for a second filing. See 28 U.S.C. § 2255 ¶ 8.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant shall have until December 12, 2005, in which to file any additional materials that he wishes the court to consider in support of his § 2255 motion. If the defendant fails to file any additional materials, the court will proceed to consider the motion as filed.
