Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the opinion and order entered herein on March 14, 2005, is AMENDED as follows:

On page 16 the first sentence under the word "Order" should read:

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Bernard Brisco's motion for relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 is DENIED, except as to defendant's claims that his attorney gave him constitutionally inadequate advice about a potential federal sentence and in failing to investigate his prior drug felony convictions for constitutional errors.

In all other respects, the order entered on March 14, 2005, remains unchanged.
