Defendant James Brooks is the only remaining defendant in this case, now that the other named defendants have settled with plaintiff. Defendant had named Robert W. Huntington, III, M.D., and Coroner John Stanley as experts; the other defendants had named Billy J. Bauman, M.D., as a medical expert and Eric Anderson as a police practices expert. Defendant has moved for permission to use his co-defendants' experts in his behalf at trial. Plaintiff objects to allowing two experts to express opinions on the cause of Jamal Mohamed's death on the ground that the evidence would be cumulative.

Before ruling on defendant's request, I will allow defendant's counsel an opportunity

to show why Bauman's testimony would not be cumulative of Huntington's. Defendant may have until January 25, 2006, in which to file and serve a reply on the subject.
