ORDER

03-CR-131-C

On January 24, 2007, this court held an initial appearance and detention hearing in this supervised release revocation case. Defendant Zachariah Spittel was present with his attorney, Richard Coad. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Robert Anderson and United States Probation Officer Helen Raatz.

Spittel waived a probable cause determination; accordingly, I held him to answer on the charges in the petition. After hearing proffers and arguments on release, I concluded that Spittel had not met his statutory burden of proving that release to the Rock Valley Correctional Center was appropriate. Accordingly, Spittel shall remain detained pending further proceedings. Spittel asked for the earliest possible date; his hearing before the district judge shall occur Wednesday, January 31, 2007 at 1:40 p.m. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
