In an order dated January 26, 2004, I concluded that plaintiff was not eligible to proceed in forma pauperis under 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and I gave plaintiff until February 12, 2004, in which to pay the \$150 filing fee. After plaintiff requested an enlargement of time, I extended this date to February 28, 2004. Plaintiff has sent the court a letter, which I construe as another motion for enlargement of time. In the letter, plaintiff writes that this court “should receive” full payment by March 15, 2004. Plaintiff’s request for additional time is GRANTED. However, plaintiff should know that this is the last extension he will be given. If the court does not receive full payment by March 15, 2004, this case will be closed and petitioner will have to continue paying the filing fee under the procedure set forth

in 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2).
