IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that jury selection is scheduled for September 25, 2006 at 9:00 A.M., and bifurcated trial to a sevenperson jury, where the issue of liability is to be determined prior to the determination of any damage, is scheduled for September 28, 2006 at 9:00 A.M., counsel to meet with the Court at 8:30 A.M. on each of said days outside the presence of the jury to resolve issues pending trial.

In the event a timely request for *certiorari* is filed, the schedule as announced herein is vacated.
