Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e), plaintiff Nancy Prochaska has moved to alter or amend the judgment entered herein on May 18, 2005. Although the motion is timely, it will be denied.

Motions to alter or amend judgment are not intended as vehicles to re-argue issues raised during the pendency of the case. Plaintiff has asserted throughout this case that the administrative law judge had misapprehended her combination of impairments argument. Both the magistrate judge and I rejected plaintiff's assertion. Reviewing plaintiff's arguments a second time does not persuade me that it was error to affirm defendant's conclusion that plaintiff did not qualify for Disability Insurance Benefits and Supplemental Security Income.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Nancy Prochaska's motion to alter or amend the judgment in this case is DENIED.
