Defendant Wood County Sheriff Deputy Todd Johnson has moved for an order permitting the use of the deposition of Ashley Pittman at trial. Because plaintiff Gary Campbell was not present at the deposition, defendant suggests that plaintiff be given an opportunity to object to any questions asked of Ms. Pittman at her deposition and to the form of the questions posed. If plaintiff has such an opportunity, I will permit defendant to use the deposition as to any questions that I do not rule to be improper or inadmissible for any reason.

Therefore, defendant is to provide plaintiff a copy of the transcript of the Pittman deposition immediately. Plaintiff may have until August 19, 2005, in which to advise the

court and opposing counsel of any objections he has to the questions put to Ms. Pittman at her deposition. Once I have received the objections, I will rule on them in a written order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that subject to plaintiff's opportunity to submit objections, defendant's motion for an order permitting use of the deposition of Ashley Pittman at trial is GRANTED. Plaintiff may have until August 19, 2005, in which to advise the court and opposing counsel of his objections to any questions.
