On May 20, 2005, I directed the federal defender to appoint an attorney to represent defendant John Spencer Fitting in this CVB traffic case, but I found that Fitting had sufficient resources to repay the government for attorney expenses in this case. Today at the sentencing I limited Fitting's repayment to the first \$300 of attorney's fees, which he is to remit to the Clerk of Court in six monthly installments.

It is ORDERED that, for the purpose of reimbursing the government for the first \$300 of the cost of his criminal defense, defendant John Fitting shall pay \$50 each month for six months to the clerk of court, starting on or before October 1, 2005 and due not later than the first of each month thereafter through March 1, 2006.
