ORDER

05-C-0638-C

Plaintiff John Kasberger has filed objections to the report and recommendation entered by the United States Magistrate Judge on June 22, 2006. The magistrate judge recommended affirming defendant Commissioner's decision to deny plaintiff's application for federal disability benefits. Plaintiff lists a plethora of reasons why this recommendation is unsupported but none of them is persuasive.

The magistrate judge explained carefully and thoroughly why the commissioner should be affirmed. As he pointed out, the administrative law judge considered all the evidence and discussed the bases for her conclusion that plaintiff is not disabled under the Social Security Act. This is not a case in which the administrative law judge failed to "build

a bridge” linking the evidence to her decision to deny benefits.

It is not necessary to repeat the magistrate judge’s reasons for rejecting plaintiff’s arguments and recommending affirmance of the commissioner’s decision. Plaintiff has not raised any new issue and the ones he raised earlier have been addressed convincingly and comprehensively by the magistrate judge.

No one reading this file could deny that plaintiff has handicaps that impair his ability to work at most kinds of jobs and that interfere with the formation of close relationships with persons outside his family. Plaintiff’s life cannot be an easy one, given his fears and phobias, but the administrative law judge was not charged with evaluating the difficulties of his life. Her job was to determine whether any substantial gainful employment existed that plaintiff could perform, given his impairments. Her conclusion that there is such work is a well reasoned one, supported by substantial evidence in the record, Therefore, this court cannot overturn it or even remand the case for further consideration.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the report and recommendation entered by the United States Magistrate Judge is ADOPTED as the court’s own. FURTHER, IT IS ORDERED that the decision of defendant Jo Anne B. Barnhart, Commissioner of Social Security, denying plaintiff John Kasberger’s applications for disability benefits under the Social Security Act

is AFFIRMED.
