Petitioner Aaron A. Kreilkamp has supplemented his request for leave to proceed <u>in</u> <u>forma pauperis</u> with an affidavit of indigency that shows he qualifies financially for pauper status. Accordingly, petitioner's request for leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> in this civil action for injunctive and monetary relief brought under Title VII, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e 2(a)(1) is GRANTED.

so, his complaint will be subject to dismissal for his failure to prosecute.
