This civil action for injunctive and monetary relief is scheduled for trial on March 19, 2007. Before the court is defendant Marshfield Clinic's unopposed motion for clarification on two points raised by the court's January 4, 2007. The motion will be granted in its entirety.

In the January 4 order, dkt. #243, at 17, I stated in error that count III of plaintiff's complaint remained at issue in this case. In fact, plaintiff voluntarily dismissed that claim in response to defendant Marshfield Clinic's motion to dismiss, filed February 28, 2006. Dkt. #14, at 1; see also Order dated May 2, 2006, dkt. #22, at 2-3. To be clear, then, let me reiterate that only one claim remains in this case: whether defendant Marshfield Clinic breached its employment contract with plaintiff by terminating him without good cause to do so, as alleged in count I of plaintiff's complaint.

Second, defendants have asked the court to formally dismiss defendants Paul Liss, John Neal, Robert Gribble, Rodney Sorenson, Donald Kelman, Kevin Ruggles, Tom Faciszewski, James Conterato, Frederic P. Wesbrook, Gary P. Mayeux, Robert A. Carlson, David J. Simenstad, Timothy R. Boyle, Daniel G. Cavanaugh, Gary R. Degerman, Douglas J. Reding and Ivan B. Schaller from this lawsuit because all plaintiffs' claims against them have been dismissed. Fiat.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1. Defendant Marshfield Clinic's motion for clarification is GRANTED.
- 2. Defendants Paul Liss, John Neal, Robert Gribble, Rodney Sorenson, Donald Kelman, Kevin Ruggles, Tom Faciszewski, James Conterato, Frederic P. Wesbrook, Gary P. Mayeux, Robert A. Carlson, David J. Simenstad, Timothy R. Boyle, Daniel G. Cavanaugh, Gary R. Degerman, Douglas J. Reding and Ivan B. Schaller are DISMISSED from this lawsuit.
