Upon application of attorney Alan H. Silberman, and upon review of the letter rogatory from the Honorable Benoit Emery, Superior Court, District of Montreal, Province of Quebec, Canada, dated November 14, 2005, seeking evidence from a representative of Weather Shield, residing within the jurisdiction of this court, for use in a judicial proceeding in the above-referenced court,

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to the authority conferred in 28 U.S.C. § 1782, and Rule 28(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, that representatives of Weather Shield residing within the jurisdiction of this Court shall provide testimony and produce documents in accordance with the letter rogatory dated November 14, 2005. Attorney Silberman shall file a motion pro hac vice with this court within five days from the date of this order.
