Under the act, plaintiff cannot proceed with this action unless the court grants him permission to proceed after screening his complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's complaint is taken under advisement.

As soon as the court's calendar permits, plaintiff's complaint will be screened pursuant to 28

U.S.C. § 1915A to determine whether the case must be dismissed either because the

complaint is frivolous or malicious, fails to state a claim on which relief may be granted or seeks monetary relief against a defendant who is immune from such relief. Plaintiff will be notified promptly when such a decision has been made.
