On October 6, 2005, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Nicolas Acosta was present with his attorney, Krista Ralston. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney John Vaudreuil.

Prior to the hearing Acosta filed a series of motions and discovery demands. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the issues with both sides, I granted the motions docketed as 147 and 148, denied 145-46 and set for briefing 149-50. No action was necessary on the discovery demand docketed as 144. Acosta must file and serve briefs in support of his remaining motions not later than October 13, 2005, with the government response by October 20, 2005, and any reply by October 27, 2005. The previously set expert disclosure deadlines of November 7 and November 21, 2005, apply

here as well. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention at this time.
