On September 21, 2005, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Rodney Spruill was present with his attorney, Michael Lieberman. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Laura Przybylinski-Finn.

Prior to the hearing Spruill filed several discovery demands and motions. I took no direct action on the discovery demands docketed as 17 and 18 except to require government disclosure of expert witnesses not later than October 3, 2005, with reciprocal defense disclosure by October 17, 2005. I denied the motion as docketed as 16.

This left Spruill's motion for disclosure of information regarding the juvenile witnesses (dkt. 15). After discussion on the record, the parties agreed that they will: investigate whether additional responsive information exists and whether it is sealed; review the applicable case law; and attempt to agree on what information, if any, shall be provided. If the parties cannot agree, then one side or the other promptly must seek relief from the court. Absent a request for court intervention, I will assume that the parties have resolved

this discovery issue without court assistance. I will rule on the motion either after the parties have requested additional court input or at the final pretrial conference, whichever occurs first.

The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. I will provide draft voir dire questions and draft jury instructions closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
