Defendant Jabar Smith has filed a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a modification of the sentence imposed upon him on August 10, 2005, by the Honorable John C. Shabaz. Defendant filed a previous § 3582 motion on December 15, 2008, dkt. 97. The federal defender, acting on defendant's behalf, and the United States Attorney briefed the motion and on January 5, 2009, I entered an order granting defendant's motion, reducing defendant's sentence of imprisonment from 294 months to 210 months. Defendant Smith has already received the benefit of a sentence reduction under 18 U.S.C. § 3582; he is not entitled to another reduction.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Jabar Smith's motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is DENIED as moot.
