In this civil action for monetary and injunctive relief, plaintiff Kenneth Awe contends that defendant Keith Govier violated his right to equal protection by promulgating and enforcing jail policies that arbitrarily permit some inmates to own a television while denying others the same privilege. On August 2, 2006, plaintiff filed a document entitled "Summary Judgment." Because his motion fails in every way to comply with this court's summary judgment procedures (a copy of which was provided to plaintiff with the preliminary pretrial conference order in this case dated July 14, 2006), plaintiff's motion will be denied. If he wishes, plaintiff may redraft his motion and proposed findings of fact in a manner consistent with the court's procedures, and refile them at any time before the October 27, 2006 dispositive motion deadline. An extra copy of the court's summary judgment procedures

will be enclosed with this order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Kenneth V. Awe's motion for summary judgment is DENIED.
