Plaintiff Orlando Larry has filed a document titled "Plaintiff's Reply to Why he Can't Make Partial Payment Fee Towards Appeal," which I construe as a request for an enlargement of time in which to submit the initial partial payment that was assessed to him in this court's order of January 11, 2007. Plaintiff says that he is unemployed and does not have anyone to support him financially anymore. He suggests that he will have to contact a relative to assist him with payment of the assessed amount.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's request for an enlargement of time in which to pay \$49.15 as an initial partial payment of the \$455 fee for filing his appeal is GRANTED. Plaintiff may have until February 28, 2007, in which to submit a check or money order made payable to the clerk of court in the amount of \$49.15. If, by February

28, 2007, plaintiff fails to pay the initial partial payment or explain his failure to do so, then I will advise the court of appeals of his noncompliance in paying the assessment so that it may take whatever steps it deems appropriate with respect to this appeal.
