This case came on for a hearing on May 17, 2006, before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb on plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order, converted to a motion for a preliminary injunction. Plaintiff appeared by T. Michael Barrett. Defendants Aegis Tools International, Inc., and Robert Birkhauser appeared by Katherine W. Schill and Joseph T. Miotke. None of the other defendants had been served; none appeared at the hearing.

For the reasons stated on the record, I found that plaintiff had shown no likelihood that it could prevail on its claims against the served defendants that defendants had violated state laws relating to unfair competition, interference with prospective economic advantage or misappropriation of product development and had failed also to show that it lacked any adequate remedy at law. Therefore, I denied plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction.
