Plaintiff Robert McGrath has written to the court to explain that he did not intend to raise claims in his complaint concerning his neck injury and his placement in temporary lock-up. Because I denied plaintiff leave to proceed on any claim he might have had concerning his neck injury and placement in temporary lock-up, there is no need to take further action with respect to those matters. One matter does require attention, however. Plaintiff's communication is accompanied by documents that plaintiff appears to wish to file as evidence in his case. However, it is not proper for plaintiff to submit evidence outside the context of a motion requiring evidentiary submissions, such as a motion for summary judgment. Because no such motion has been filed in the case, I have placed a copy of the documents in the court's file for record purposes only and am returning the originals to plaintiff for his use at a later time.
