Petitioner requests leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u>. Attached to his affidavit of indigency is a proposed complaint.

Petitioner alleges that respondent Kevin Kennedy, Executive Director of the State of Wisconsin Elections Board, prevented him from being placed on the ballot as a candidate for the office of Representative for the Assembly because of a pre-1996 felony conviction. He alleges that this is an ex-post facto violation because the law preventing him from being placed on the ballot was applied to conduct occurring prior to its passage.

Petitioner may have stated a claim under federal law. Accordingly, he will be allowed to proceed on his claim against respondent Kevin Kennedy.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's request to proceed <u>in forma</u> <u>pauperis</u> is GRANTED. Hudson v. Kennedy, 06-C-506-S
