In an order dated December 6, 2006, I scheduled a hearing on plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction for January 5, 2007, at 1:30 p.m. Having reviewed defendants' motion to reschedule the hearing, and finding good cause to do so, I will grant the motion and reschedule the hearing for January 9, 2007 at 1:30 p.m.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

1. Defendants' "Motion to Reschedule Evidentiary Hearing" is GRANTED. The evidentiary hearing is rescheduled to January 9, 2007 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 250 at the

U.S. District Courthouse in Madison, Wisconsin.

2. Plaintiff may have until December 27, 2006, in which to submit any requests for issuance of writs of habeas corpus ad testificandum he may have, seeking to secure the appearance at the hearing of any incarcerated witness having first hand knowledge of defendant Larson's alleged refusal to provide plaintiff with appropriate medical care.

3. The writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum issued for plaintiff to appear at the previously scheduled January 5, 2007 hearing is AMENDED to provide that plaintiff is to appear on January 9, 2007.
