This case was closed on November 9, 2007 when judgment was entered after a jury returned a verdict in favor of defendant Ken Greetan. Now, a little more than four years later, plaintiff Charles Wilson has filed a motion titled “motion for reimbursement of overpaid filing fee” in this case. In his motion, plaintiff states that the court incorrectly ordered plaintiff to pay a filing fee of \$355. Plaintiff states that the correct fee to file a civil case in United States District Court is \$350 and he asks for a refund of \$5.00. Plaintiff’s motion will be denied.

Plaintiff is incorrect in his assertion that the court ordered him to pay a \$355 filing fee in this case. In the October 23, 2006 order assessing plaintiff’s initial partial payment in this case, the court stated correctly that the filing fee was \$350. In addition, I have

reviewed the court's financial records for this case. The records show that plaintiff made the \$8.93 initial partial payment of the \$350 fee for filing his complaint, as well as subsequent payments collected in monthly installments pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2). The total that plaintiff has paid in this case amounts to \$347.31. Plaintiff still owes \$2.69. I am enclosing with this order a copy of the statement that shows plaintiff's filing fee payments for this case and a copy of the October 23, 2006 order assessing the filing fee.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Charles Wilson's motion for reimbursement of his allegedly overpaid filing fee, dkt. #56, is DENIED.
