ORDER OF DETENTION
PENDING TRIAL

06-CR-107-C

On May 15, 2006 this court convened a hearing on the government's motion to detain defendant Bruce P. Hunt in this unlawful possession of ammunition case. Defendant is not yet ready to respond to the government's motion, so he is not contesting detention at this time. Based on this and based on the currently uncontested information contained in the pretrial service report, I conclude that defendant is a flight risk and a danger to the community. Defendant may request a substantive release hearing whenever he is ready; at any such hearing it would be the government's burden to establish grounds for continued detention.

It is ORDERED that the defendant is committed to the custody of the United States Marshals Service for confinement at the Dane County Jail separate from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal. The defendant shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity for private consultation with his attorney. On order of this court or on request of an attorney for the Government, the Dane County Jail shall deliver the defendant to the Marshals Service for the purpose of an appearance in this case.
