PRETRIAL MOTIONS

On January 11, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Gary Dausey waived his personal presence, but was represented by Attorney Dennis Ryan. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Elizabeth Altman.

After discussing the course of discovery, I set a briefing schedule on defendant's motion to suppress evidence (dkt. 7). Defendant's first brief must be filed and served by January 22, 2007, with the government's response filed and served not later than January 29, 2007 and any defense reply filed and served by February 5, 2007. Same day service is required. The parties had no other substantive matters to bring to the court's attention. I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
