On November 27, 2006, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Gregory Williams was present with his attorney, Paul F.X. Schwartz. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Rita Rumbelow.

Prior to the hearing, Williams filed a series of discovery demands and motions. After discussing the motions and the course of discovery with both sides, I granted the motions docketed as 17 and 18 and denied those docketed as 15, 16, 19, 20 and 21. No action was necessary on the discovery demand docketed as 14. As I advised the parties, if they cannot resolve the confidential informant issue informally, Attorney Schwartz promptly should contact the court to ask for input. Because the parties anticipate resolving this case short of trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to

the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
