PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-192-S

On December 18, 2006 this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Gregory Bucheger was present with his attorney, Bruce J. Rosen. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Peter M. Jarosz. Prior to the hearing the defendant filed a series of discovery motions and demands, and the government filed a request for notice of alibi. After discussing the motions and demands with both sides, I directed how certain issues were to be addressed then granted the motions docketed as 11, 13 and 14, granted in part and denied in part the motions docketed as 12 and 15, and took no direct action on the demands docketed as 16-18. Because Bucheger has eschewed an alibi defense, the government's request for notice falls by the boards. The government must disclose its expert witnesses not later than January 8, 2007 with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by January 22, 2007. The parties must contact the court immediately in the event they encounter new discovery disputes that they cannot resolve quickly between themselves. Because it is not yet clear whether this case is going to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir

dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
