PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

On January 29, 2007, this court held a telephonic pretrial motion hearing at the request of counsel. Defendant De Ann Taft did not participate personally, but was represented by her attorney, Stephen Mays. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Paul Connell.

Prior to the hearing, Taft filed a series of discovery demands and motions. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 13, denied 11, 12 and 14-20, and took no action on the requests docketed as 8-10. The parties had no other substantive matters to bring to the court's attention. Because this case probably will not go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
