In an order entered on June 10, 2008, I stayed a decision on defendant James Alphonse's motion for reduction of his sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582, pending the holding of an evidentiary hearing on the motion. Now defendant's counsel has written to the court to advise it that defendant no longer contends that he is entitled to any sentence lower than the mandatory minimum sentence of 120 months.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant's motion for a reduction of sentence under 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is GRANTED. Defendant is resentenced to a term of 120 months. In all

other respects, his sentence remains as imposed on him on August 15, 2007.
