In November 2011, defendant James Frazier moved for a sentencing reduction under 18 U.S.C. § 3582. His motion was denied on December 2, 2012 because at sentencing his sentence was determined by his status as a career offender and not by drug quantity and thus he is not entitled to the reduction.

Now defendant has filed another $\S 3582$ motion. Because defendant failed to appeal the December 2, 2012 order, he is not entitled to file another motion seeking the same relief as his previous motion.

ORDER

Defendant James Frazier's motion for a reduction of sentence under 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is DENIED because the court lacks the authority to grant it.
