The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney O'Shea.

After taking a discovery proffer from the government, the court set a briefing schedule on the defendants' motions to suppress evidence (dkt. 27) and to provide more information about the confidential informant (dkt. 28). Defense briefs in support of either motion must be filed and served by February 8, 2007, with the government's response due February 15, 2007 and any reply filed by February 21, 2007. Because this case is unlikely to go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties'

submission deadline for the final pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
