PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-227-C

On February 21, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant James Lowe was present with his attorney, Corey Chirafisi. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Rita Rumbelow.

Prior to the hearing, Lowe filed a set of discovery motions and requests. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the submissions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 17, denied 13 and 16, and took no action on the requests docketed as 14-15. The government must disclose its expert witnesses not later than March 19, 2007, with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by April 2, 2007. Because it is unclear whether this case will go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
