ORDER OF DETENTION
PENDING TRIAL

06-CR-228-S

At the December 20, 2006 arraignment the government moved pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §3142(f) to detain defendant Jeremy Schade in this child pornography case,. Because the government has charged defendant with violating 18 U.S.C. § 2251(a), there is a rebuttable presumption of detention. Defendant currently is in state custody for failure to make bond on related charges, so he is not contesting detention at this time but has reserved his right to a full substantive hearing if his circumstances change.

It is ORDERED that the defendant is committed to the custody of the United States Marshals Service for confinement at a proximate jail separate from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal. The defendant shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity for private consultation with his attorney. On order of this court or on request of an attorney for the Government, the jail shall deliver the defendant to the Marshals Service for the purpose of an appearance in this case.
