It appears that the court will have to referee the issue of destructive testing. Plaintiff supports his motion to extend his deadline to conduct destructive testing (dkt. 14) with an affidavit from counsel (dkt. 15) predicting that defendant Vitense will object to providing a DNA specimen for testing. For this reason, among others, plaintiff asks to extend his testing deadline from April 30, 2007, to July 31, 2007. Any procedural objections to an extension must be filed and served by May 4, 2007. Plaintiff may not reply.

Defendant Vitense—and any other defendant who objects to providing samples or has some other substantive objection to destructive testing—must file and serve a motion for protection and all support not later than May 7, 2007. Plaintiff's response is due May 11, 2007. There shall be no reply. Same day service is required.
