In consultation with the parties, the court determined that it would be inefficient at this juncture to set an entire schedule for this case. Defendants all agreed to file their briefs in opposition not later than April 17, 2007, with plaintiffs' reply due not later than April 24, 2007. Same-day service of all briefs is required.

In the interim, the parties may complete discovery already commenced in state court, and plaintiffs will file a reply to the pending motion to compel discovery not later than April 17, 2007. We will wait to sort out the deposition disputes until we determine which court will hear this case. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
