At the February 3, 2011 status conference, the court discussed with the parties and set

the dates in consultation with counsel:

Plaintiff's response to defendant's motion to vacate judgment on costs, dkt. 502, is due

February 18, 2011, with any reply due February 25, 2011. Defendant voluntarily has

withdrawn its motion to dissolve the injunction, dkt. 504, while reserving the right to re-file the

motion if necessary.

Plaintiff intends to seek leave to file a summary judgment motion before trial. Plaintiff

need not accompany its motion for leave with a proposed summary judgment motion (or the

usual corollary submissions). Defendant's response will be due seven calendar days after service

of the motion for leave, with any reply due seven calendar days later.

Disclosure of Experts: Proponent: May 2, 2011

Respondent: June 3, 2011

The parties dispute whether the court should allow updated liability expert reports. It

is up to the parties to bring this dispute to the court's attention in a motion with a response due

seven calendar days later and a reply due seven calendar days after the response.

Discovery Cutoff: July 29, 2011.

If the parties dispute the parameters of discovery, it is up timely to them to bring their

disputes to the court's attention in a motion, which will be handled as explained in the

preliminary pretrial conference order, dkt. 20, except that the response deadline is extended to

seven calendar days.

Final Pretrial Conference: August 18 at 4:00 p.m.

The procedures governing the 2008 final pretrial conference govern this final pretrial

conference as well.

Jury Selection and Trial: August 29, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

The parties predict a three to five day trial. The procedures governing the 2008 trial

govern this trial as well.
