Upon receipt of plaintiff's partial filing fee in the amount of \$5.60, the Court addresses the merits of plaintiff's complaint. According to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2), the institution's financial officer is authorized to deduct monthly payments from plaintiff's account until the \$350.00 filing fee is paid in full.

Plaintiff seeks to release from state custody. He appears to be challenging his state court convictions. His proper remedy is under 28 U.S.C. §2254. He has not alleged, however, that he has exhausted his state court remedies. His complaint under 42 U.S.C. §1983 must be dismissed.

Plaintiff is advised that in any future proceedings in this matter he must offer argument not cumulative of that already

provided to undermine this Court's conclusion that his claim must be dismissed. See Newlin v. Helman, 123 F.3d 429, 433 (7th Cir. 1997) .

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's complaint and all claims contained therein is DISMISSED without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment be entered DISMISSING plaintiff's complaint and all claims therein without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for appointment of counsel is DENIED as moot.
